TEACHER RESPONSIBILITIES

I will teach students the art of singing in a positive and enthusiastic environment. I strive to guide each student in discovering their own unique voice and working towards fulfilling their full vocal potential. I will tailor the curriculum and instruction based on the student's long-term and short-term goals, interests, and needs, as determined in cooperation between the student, myself, and parents/guardians (for students under 18).

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Students agree to arrive at each lesson punctually, well-prepared, and with their music, and any other materials. A piano will be provided in lessons. To make good progress, regular quality practice is necessary. Please ask questions about home assignments so that the student can completely understand the assignments and goals.

LESSON PAYMENTS AND SCHEDULE

Lesson fees as of December 2024 are \$175/hr for a single lesson, or \$650 for a package of four lessons to be used within 30 days. I encourage regular sessions for steady progress, but do not require a specific frequency or number of lessons to join the studio. I am also glad to offer *interest-free* payments for lesson packages.

Lesson payment is due at the time of booking.

Payments are accepted via Stripe using credit or debit card. To make a payment via Zelle, Paypal, Venmo, Cash, or Check, please contact Julian directly.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Lessons canceled with under 24 hours notice will not be provided a makeup lesson. Lessons canceled with 24 hours notice will be credited a makeup lesson to be used the same month. For in-person lessons canceled with less than 48 hours notice, the student is responsible for paying the room reservation fee of \$25. The makeup lesson will be scheduled based on teacher availability. Lessons canceled by the teacher will be given as much notice as possible and will be rescheduled within 30 days.

MUSIC & MATERIALS

Each student is responsible for purchasing the required music and materials for lessons. Materials will be assigned by me and the student will be expected to have the materials no later than two weeks after the materials have been assigned. Advanced notice will be provided whenever possible.

COMMITMENT

While I do not require it, I recommend new students commit to regular sessions for at least

three months. This gives both the singer and the teacher time to learn one another's styles. Training as a singer takes time and dedication; it doesn't happen overnight!

Please note that a student's spot cannot be guaranteed if they choose to pause lessons and resume at a later date.

If you decide to discontinue lessons, please provide me with at least two weeks notice to allow me time to fill your spot.

From time to time, I use photos and short videos of my students around the studio, on the studio website, or in social media posts. These videos and posts are encouraging to other students and helpful to other teachers. If you do not want your child's image(s) to be used, please let me know.
